- There are several lines belonging to Parent Council. Each year we need to report to the board, what our plan is for the usage of these funds.

##### School Programming

- E-hub – Heather Cumming – growing number of students selecting online courses. This section (first semester), is to help students manage the platform.
- Pathways teacher – Nick Keller – will support multiple pathway items. One specifically being the SHSM. Would be happy to talk to a parent group (perhaps as a forum before a Parent Council Mtg)
- iPad Distribution – We have been working at distributing the ipads this past week.
  - Grade 12's did a survey indicating if they would prefer a chromebook/ipad or BYOD
  - The results were: 65.1% would prefer to receive the same Chromebook they were issued last year
  - 14.3% would prefer to receive an iPad2 or an iPad mini
  - 20.6% would rather not receive any device as they have their own.

Grade 7's received new ipads today. Grade's 8 through 11 over the last few days. Some glitches we are working through, as this is the first time for this process to occur.
